McLean and Colin D. Brousson, counsel for the Petitioners, and other counsel as listed on Schedule "A" hereto; AND UPON READING the material filed; AND pursuant to the *Companies' Creditors Arrangement Act*, R.S.C. 1985 c. C-36, Rules 3, 10, 12, 13(1), 13(6), 14 and 44 of the Rules of Court and the inherent jurisdiction of this Honourable Court:

THIS COURT ORDERS that:


1. all of the relief granted by the Initial Order made herein on July 31, 2008, as amended by the Order of Mr. Justice Leask on August 15, 2008 (the "Order") is hereby confirmed and the relief provided therein and all stays provided therein are hereby extended to October 31, 2008, subject to any further extension application by the Petitioners to be brought on or before October 28, 2008;
2. the application of the Canadian Imperial Bank of Commerce be and is hereby adjourned generally;
3. the application of GE Canada Leasing Services Company and General Electric Canada Equipment Financing G.P. be and is hereby adjourned generally;
4. the Monitor is to issue a report on September 30, 2008;
5. the applications of Teal Cedar Products Ltd. and Western Forest Products Inc. to set aside the Order made herein on July 31, 2008 is adjourned with liberty to reapply after October 1, 2008 to terminate the stay, but not on the basis of material non-disclosure by the Petitioners on the initial *ex parte* application;
6. the stay of proceedings granted in the Initial Order made herein on July 31, 2008 in these proceedings does not apply with respect to Supreme Court of British Columbia, Vancouver Registry Action No. S082076;

7. approval as to the form of the Order herein be and is hereby dispensed with, except for counsel for the Petitioners.
