
THE APPLICATION of the Petitioners coming on for hearing before me this day at Vancouver, British Columbia; AND ON HEARING Colin D. Brousson, counsel for the Petitioners, and other counsel as listed on Schedule "A" hereto; AND UPON READING the material filed; AND pursuant to the *Companies' Creditors Arrangement Act*, R.S.C. 1985 c. C-36, Rules 3, 10, 12, 13(1), 13(6), 14 and 44 of the Rules of Court and the inherent jurisdiction of this Honourable Court:

THIS COURT ORDERS AND DIRECTS that:


- 1. all the relief granted by the Honourable Mr. Justice Burnyeat in the Initial Order made herein on July 31, 2008, as amended by the Order of Mr. Justice Leask made herein on

August 15, 2008 and further amended by Orders made herein on September 4, 2008, and October 31, 2008 is hereby extended to September 30, 2009 (the "Extension Period");

2. During the Extension Period, the Petitioners be and are hereby authorized to continue to sell the remainder of their assets, provided any such sale is approved by the Monitor and the Canadian Imperial Bank of Commerce, and subject to any required consents unless such consent is waived or dispensed with by further Order;
3. After June 12, 2009, GE Canada Leasing Services Company and General Electric Canada Equipment Financing G.P ("GE") will be at liberty to apply to lift the stay imposed in these CCAA proceedings as it concerns GE;
4. After July 17, 2009, Western Forest Products Ltd. ("Western") and Teal Cedar Products Ltd. ("Teal") will be at liberty to apply to lift the stay imposed in these proceedings as it concerns Teal and Western and the Bill 13 contracts between Hayes and Western and Hayes and Teal.
5. the Monitor, in addition to any special reports on specific issues, will file a report with the Court in these proceedings, including any non-confidential general matters concerning the state of and progress of the sale of the Petitioners' assets, on May 29, 2009, July 31, 2009 and September 28, 2009; and
6. approval of this Order by counsel other than counsel for the Petitioners is hereby dispensed with.
